

Chocolate Box



Steps:

1. We have used store bought chocolates to jazz up for a Mother's Day gift. However, you can use whichever chocolates you like, perhaps be adventurous and make your own!
2. We worked out how many different types there were so we could do each type in a different colour. Once you know many colours you need, group your chocolates together so you can each colour in one batch at a time.
3. With a fork give your Liquid Magic a quick stir to ensure a smooth consistency, especially if it has separated a little.
4. Put your chocolate on your fork and put into your Liquid Magic (if you have a specialist chocolate fork – use this)
5. Pull your fork (with chocolate on) out of the Liquid Magic.
6. Tap fork on the side of your bucket/container to remove all excess Liquid magic.
7. Place your chocolate on a drip tray to allow any excess Liquid Magic to drip off.
8. Repeat Steps 3 – 7 to finish all your chocolates. Leave them on the drip tray to dry.
9. We placed each chocolate in a mini brown patty case to present each chocolate.
10. Find a container* that you want to present your chocolates in. Then arrange chocolate in patty cases to look appealing.
11. Repeat this process until your container is full.
12. We wrapped a ribbon on the lid and attached a gift tag.
