

Packaging for Chocolate Box



Steps:

1. Find a box you want to use for your chocolates. The box I wanted to use was too high for 1 layer of chocolates, but I still wanted to use it – so I created an insert. See steps below.
2. I wanted to make an insert to either put 2 layers of chocolates or have the chocolates presented higher in the box, so I started with a template using scrap paper first to get the correct measurement's.
3. Once you are happy with the insert, find some thicker paper or card in the colour/style you want to use and replicate the template you made in scrap paper.
4. Push the side of the insert together to put it into the box. You want it to be a tight fit.
5. Gently push the insert down so it touches the bottom of the box.
6. There should be a big enough gap from the top of the box to the insert so you can fit your chocolates in on both levels.
7. Now you can put your chocolates into the box and you have a really presentable gift for Mother's Day or be creative and use for other occasions.
